


# British Coal Staff Superannuation Scheme

Over the last quarter we engaged with 50 companies held in the British Coal Staff Superannuation Scheme portfolios on a range of 115 social, environmental and governance issues.






#### **Developed Asia**

We engaged with ten companies over the last quarter.





We engaged with ten companies over the last quarter.




#### Europe

We engaged with nine companies over the last quarter.




#### North America
